

## STORY TELLING IDEAS



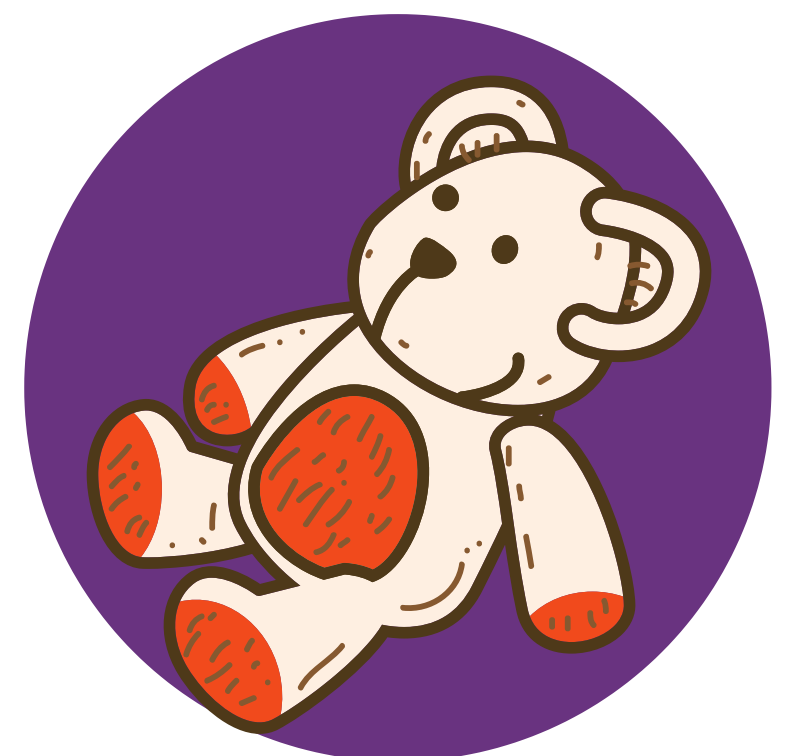
### REMINISCING

Remember together. Share stories from your lives together, including people, places and events.



### "CHOOSE 3"

Ask your child to name three things - for example: A dragon, an icecream truck and a river. Enjoy creating a story together.



### BUDDY TALES

Using your child's soft toy take turns having a pretend conversation. Move the toys as you talk, ask questions and use funny voices.



### STORY BASKET

Gather items from around the house and pop them in a basket or box. Use these to create a story. Items such as toys, shells, hats make for an interesting story!



### ONE SENTENCE EACH

Tell a story as a family. Each person takes it in turns. See where your imagination takes you!



### EVERYWHERE

Stories can be enjoyed anywhere, anytime! Long or short, your child will love to hear your voice as you improvise.
